What do you need to have ready for October 13th?

You will need the following information to apply for most schools:

- Social security number
- Info for people who would write you a letter of recommendation if it is required
- List of Honors, achievements, extracurricular activities

Log into Student Connect:

- Your transcript (you can have the page open or print it before hand)
- Your GPA

Each public four-year college and university will have a unique fee waiver process; some will ask you to submit codes, while others will ask you to select an answer from a dropdown menu. Please read instructions carefully as you prepare to submit applications on Tuesday, October 13. For institutions using fee waiver codes, we have highlighted the codes in **red**.

If you click on the college or university name in the chart it will take you straight to the application page.

What should you do before Application Day?

- Decide which colleges you will be applying to
- Complete the application, all except for paying for the application fee
- Only use the Common Application if you are applying to more than one college that uses it— so research it
- Add the colleges you are applying to Naviance so your counselor can send out your transcripts.
