# MTSS Systems and Protocols (MIS #3)

Mann Middle School staff will implement a school-wide MTSS system that examines Early Warning System (EWS) data to provide Tier 2 and Tier 3 interventions for students that require additional support.

**Measurement:** Fall to Spring benchmark growth, CMAS growth, 5 Essentials Survey Data, EWI Data (attendance, behavior, core academics)

#### **EOY Goal: Attendance**

By May 26, 2023, student attendance rate will increase to 91% or better.

#### **EOY Goal: Behavior**

By May 26, 2023, the number of student discipline referrals resulting in out-of-school suspension will decrease by 25% using Q1 data as a baseline.

#### **EOY Goal: Core Academics**

The number of students passing all classes will increase by 25% when compared to Q1 data.

#### General

- Clearly communicate PRIDE expectations to students, staff, and families
  - **Measure**: PRIDE Assemblies, Attendance at Parent meetings
- Consistent MTSS meetings using EWI data for attendance, behavior, and core classes (passing grades)
  - Measure: EWI Data, MTSS notes

#### **Attendance**

- Establish systems and protocols to increase attendance rates (exincentives, parent communication, home visits)
  - Measure: EWI Data, Attendance Data

#### **Behavior**

- Professional Development opportunities on tier 1, tier 2, and tier 3 behavior support strategies for the classroom
  - **Measure**: Participation Rates in PD, Discipline Data
- Collaboratively develop a discipline matrix that is communicated to staff, students and families and followed with consistency (classroom managed vs. office managed)
  - Measure: EWI Data, Discipline Data, Parent Communication
- Establish a PBIS reward system based on student feedback
  - Measure: Participants in quarterly rewards, Lancer Card collection, EWI Data

#### **Core Academics**

- Tutoring opportunities provided for all students (Power Hour)
  - Measure: Attendance at Power Hour, Passing Grades Data
- Identify student learning gaps and provide targeted intervention in Math (initially)
  - Measure: STAR Benchmark Data, Interim Assessment Data, Progress Monitoring Data
