How to Take, Save, and Share Screenshots on Your Chromebook

To take a screenshot of the <u>entire screen</u>, use the **Ctrl + Show windows** key combination. The Show windows key, which looks like a rectangle with two lines on the right side, is on the top row of the keyboard above the 6 and 7 keys.



To take a screenshot of a <u>portion of the screen</u>, press the **Shift + Ctrl + Show windows** keys. You will see a crosshair icon; click and drag it until the part of the screen you want to copy is highlighted, and then let go.

OK...So Where Did It Go?

Any screenshot you take will end up in your Downloads folder. To find your downloads folder:

- Select the Launcher at the left corner of your screen.
- Look for the icon named "Files" under the search field. If you do not see it, select the up arrow and look for the "Files" app there.
- That icon will bring up your file manager. Look for your Downloads folder under the "My Files" category on the left. Your screenshots will be there.

So How Do I Share the Saved Screenshot?

Well, that will depend on the way your teacher created the assignment. But once the screenshot is saved as a file in your Downloads folder and you know how to find it, you can do any of the following just as you would with any other file type.

- Upload the file to a Schoology Assignment and submit it
- Insert the file into a Google Doc, Word Doc, Google Slide, PowerPoint slide, Google Drawing, etc.
- Email it as an attachment
- Upload the file to your Google Drive or One Drive or OneNote Notebook
- And more!
