#### Attendance

#### Grading

Grades will be recorded into Q the same as in-person learning. Assignments will be clearly posted with due dates on the teacher's Schoology page. It is the responsibility of the student to keep track of, complete, and turn in assignment by the due date.

STUDENT TIP 1: Develop a way of organizing your task to-do list to keep track of what needs to be accomplished.

STUDENT TIP 2: Check StudentConnect in Q at least once a week to make sure you are not only staying caught up but turning in quality work to earn the highest grades possible.
