

Dear Jaguar Nation Families,








1. Go to www.schoology.com




5. This is the screen you should see next. This is where you will put in the Access Code that will be provided by your child's 7th period/JAG Time teacher. Make to enter the access code EXACTLY as you see it. (it is case sensitive).



- 6. Enter your First name, Last name, your email address, and create a password that you will remember. There are no limits for the password and make sure that you use an ACTIVE email account. **the blacked out part is an access code used for this example. You WILL NOT see this blacked out on your end.**
