Kindergarten – Mrs. Niolon's class 84%


1st grade – Mrs. Lutze's class 85%

• The class with the highest attendance percentage throughout 4th quarter will earn the opportunity to tape our Principal, Mrs. Slyter to the gymnasium wall!




The second-place class will be able to silly string their teacher!

Practice at home math and reading

A few simple ideas to support your child's learning at home.

- · Read aloud to your child
- Listen to your child read aloud
- Practice sight words together (search online for grade level word lists such as the Dolch Word List or Fry Word List)
- Practice math facts (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division)
- Keep a writing journal and encourage your student to write in it often.

 They can write about their day or do some creative writing.
