Everyone is invited to participate in Adams PTSCO Fun Run/Walk. Course is approximately 0.3 miles long with 6 different color blast stations along the path. Participants can run or walk the course as many times as they would like, getting blasted with colored power each time they pass through a color station. Participants should wear white or light colored clothing to make the colored powder more visible and vibrant.

Participation fee is \$5.00 per person or \$20.00 per family (families must live in same household) - participation fee covers entry into the run/walk, 1 pair of sunglasses per person, and 1 bottle of water per person.

Participants are encouraged to pre-register. Payment is due at time of registration. Participants can register a the day of the event up to the start of the run/walk.


#### **Lunch Sales**

Monday- No School


Tuesday- Create Unity Flags in your Classroom
