AUTHORIZED USE OF SCHOOL-OWNED MATERIALS OR EQUIPMENT

(Regulation) Policy

The following regulations apply to the use of books and other materials by students at home:

1. It is not desirable to send home basic textbooks in elementary grades. However in case of extended absence or if special practice is needed, books and other materials may be provided. Because it is natural for a student to want to read stories in advance, it is not advisable to send home the basic reader unless the student already has finished the book.

If a student needs practice in reading supplementary materials, library books at his level should be provided.

Students should be constantly encouraged to do recreational reading and participate in projects or activities at home that are of an educational nature.

2. In the middle schools and high schools, basic books may be provided in classes where outside study is necessary.
