## SPECIAL NEEDS STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) includes transportation under its related services provisions. In compliance with IDEA, Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District) shall provide transportation services to students who have transportation as a related service specified as part of their Individualized Education Program (IEP).

The District shall also provide transportation services to students who qualify for services as part of a 504 plan. Section 504 covers qualified students with disabilities who attend schools in districts receiving federal financial assistance.

The Superintendent shall ensure that regulations are developed to implement the details of this policy.
