## STUDENT ACTIVITIES (CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRACURRICULAR)

Student activities shall be regarded as a student privilege and a part of the total educational program and shall be used as a means of developing the whole child into an empowered citizen.

All student activities shall be carried on under the authority of the Colorado Springs School District 11 Board of Education and its delegated administrators.

Co-Curricular and extracurricular activities held in the name of or under the auspices of a school shall be under the general supervision of the principal and the sponsor or sponsors of that activity. The school's administration shall provide adequate supervision, administer student finances and approve all student activities with the assistance of delegated members of the staff.

Districtwide events shall require the approval of the Superintendent or designee.

Extracurricular activities do not take precedence in importance over the subject matter areas. These activities should offer students opportunities to apply and transfer studies by extending, enhancing and/or supplementing the applicable courses of study.

All activities affiliated with a school shall be open to all students of the school.
