STUDENT PERFORMANCES/EXHIBITS/COMPETITION

The Colorado Springs School District 11 Board of Education recognizes that educational values accrue from student participation in civic and community affairs. Instructors may encourage students to contribute to public performances when their contribution will support their educational process and objectives and when their contribution does not interfere unduly with other scheduled classes or activities within the school.

Assemblies, public programs and public performances by students shall be consistent with the educational goals of the District (graduate profile – go to d11.org>academics>graduate profile). Wide participation in the programs should be encouraged.
